About Victoria Forms

Victoria Solutions Limited (trading as Victoria Forms) was established in 2003, with our core business built around electronic forms systems. Our customers include 1 in 5 UK Local Authorities, with our eForms being used for a wide variety of government tasks.

In 2018 we launched VF Creator for Word, an add-in for Microsoft Word which allows users to design their own forms which work with our eForms system. This has enabled us to expand into other industry sectors and other countries, including our first US local government customers.

Since 2017 we have been developing an entirely new version of our main eForms system, *Enterprise Forms Server* (Classic ASP), using Angular and ASP.NET Core. We have a wide variety of integrations with other systems, including CRM systems, payment providers, online mapping and messaging.

Job Description

The developer will work as part of a small team creating a range of exciting new products and features around our eForms system and maintaining our existing software.

We use Visual Studio 2017 and/or Visual Studio Code, alongside Jira, Confluence, Team Foundation Server, Git, Slack, Skype and My Hours.

The majority of the developer's time will be on development tasks assigned via Jira, but they will also be involved in weekly tech team meetings and contributing to specifications.

In addition, the developer will occasionally:

- Provide support and/or training to customers.
- Contribute to documentation.
- Assist with setting up of servers.
- Perform any other tasks as reasonably required.

Primary technical skillset: C#, ASP.NET and ASP.NET Core (MVC, Entity Framework), Angular 7, TypeScript, SQL Server, HTML, JavaScript, CSS, Sass and VSTO.

Secondary technical skillset: React, Visual Basic .NET, Classic ASP, Visual Basic and Windows Server setup and maintenance (including IIS).
